On the next few pages you will find the regs and entry forms for the above enduro. At the end is the Parental Agreement Form for riders under 18yrs and our Membership Form for those of you that wish to join the club – but it is not necessary as long as you have an ACU or SACU Enduro Licence.

PLEASE NOTE - NO DAY LICENCES WILL BE AVAILABLE, YOU MUST APPLY TO THE ACU / SACU FOR A COMETITION LICENCE

Last Posting Date – you will note that we have included this as we will be unable to accept late entries – if I don't have fully completed entry forms and entry fee by Wednesday 20th April 2011, you will not be included. **So please remember POST THEM FIRST CLASS BY Monday 18 April 2011**

Preferred Rider No: If you have a number on your bike and would like to keep it just put a note on your entry and I will try to give it to you if possible. However perhaps it is worth bearing in mind that the earlier you get your entry in the higher up the riding order you are in your class as only Rider numbers 1, 2 and 3 have been requested by the SACU to be set aside.

Rider Numbers & Results: We will not be posting out rider numbers these will be posted on the Scottish Enduros <http://www.scottishenduros.co.uk/> and Melville <http://www.melvillemc.co.uk/> websites on 13 April and final listing on 20 April, get your entry in early if you need your number quickly. Results will be posted in the same way as soon as possible after the event.

Information from the SACU: Once again for 2011 clubs are to remind riders that there is no temporary disablement insurance carried on the event insurance. You can obtain one event – or full season insurance on a personal basis by applying to Lockton Companies International Tel 0161 828 3326 or e-mail to dawn.luby@uk.lockton.com.

Clubs must check that any non ACU or SACU riders have appropriate start permission from their respective Unions eg MCUI of Ireland. This ensures they have repatriation insurance in case of injury. If this effects your entry please bring it to our attention.

There will be a designated area for camping on Friday and Saturday night. Bikes must not be started between the hours of 6.30pm and 9am on Friday, Saturday or Sunday.

Note no 1 minute Late Arrival Allowance as stated in ESR 3.12 (e) in the 2008 ACU Handbook. Therefore if a rider is late arriving at a Timecheck he will be penalized 60 points per minute that he is late, according to the time indicated on the Official Clock.

Noise Limits: The official ACU/SACU limits for 2008 is 94 Db for Enduro - this is measured at 20cm. (85 Db measured at 2 metres). There will be testing at events this year. Noisy bikes will be excluded, the Club has noise meters - so check it before you race

Note to all riders - please ensure you have the correct number background for your class. Expert - Red or green on all sides, Clubman and O-40 Yellow front, Sportsman Black front all sides.

Environmental:-

The use of power washers, anywhere on the farm, is strictly prohibited. Any rider or member of their support team found in breach of this rule will have the bike and rider excluded from the event.

All Riders (and their support team) must, when refuelling or maintaining their bikes, use an environmental mat, (eg piece of carpeting), no fuelling in grassed overflow car park area

Finally please remember to bring a bin bag and take all your rubbish home with you for disposal, your support with this will be appreciated.

Attention Novice Riders – remember whatever time you finish your riding for the day make sure you hand in your timecard at the start check because it is the only way we know that you are safely off the course and until we can account for each and every rider, by having all the timecards, the organisers, marshal's and first aiders cannot go home.

Abuse to officials will not be tolerated under any circumstances, any one found giving abuse will be excluded from this and future events, you have been warned.

Supplementary Regs

for the

1st and 2nd Rounds of the SACU Scottish Enduro Championship

23 & 24 April 2011

SACU Permit Numbers: 11/040 and 11/041

Venue:-

Blackcastle farm south of Pathhead, the start will be signposted from the Tynehead turnoff on the A68 and A7.

Assembly/Signing on will be at 9.00am.

- Scrutineering from 9.00am – 10.00am. **Penalty for late scrutineering - 60 points.**
- First man leaves at 10:30am.

Route:-

Approx 15 miles over open farmland and woodland, marked by tape, rope and Day-Glo arrows.

Eligibility:-

- Expert, Clubman E1, E2 & E3, Clubman B (incl over 50's), Over 40's and Sportsman classes.
- No day licences will be available.

Entries:-

- Completed entries to be returned to – Valerie O'Neill, 31 Chester View Bonnyrigg Midlothian EH19

Entries and fees will not be returned unless the event is cancelled or a rider gives a valid reason for not riding at least seven days prior to the event. In such cases £10 will be deducted to cover costs. Any rider not signing on, on the day, will forfeit his entry fee in full.

Entries close on Wednesday 20th April or when full. No late entries will be accepted.

LAST FIRST CLASS POSTING DATE: Monday 18 April 2011.

Scrutineering:-

Riders must sign on prior to scrutineering. Riders must present their machines along with an ACU approved stamped helmet, a dog tag (I.D. Disc with Name, Date of Birth and Blood Group, if known).

Note: Helmets will be checked again at start line (So those of you who present a different helmet for scrutineering than what they actually use to race will not be allowed to start). Please ensure you have correct colour of background and numbers for you class.

Starting:-

Each rider will receive a time card at signing on for the days run. At the beginning of the enduro collect your machine from the Parc Ferme just before your start time. Present your machine on the start line at your due time. DO NOT START your engine before your start time. On your minute – start the machine and proceed around the course. If you are not at the start line at the appropriate time you will not be penalized providing you bring your machine to the start line, start it and cross the 20 metre line within one minute of your designated start time. If you exceed this one-minute you will be penalized 20 points. You may then start your machine in any manner you desire, but you must cross the start line before proceeding en-route.

Refuelling:-

- Must only take place in designated areas, between white and yellow flags and between check and green flags.
- All crews must provide a fire extinguisher.

- Each machine should be refuelled on an environmental mat.
NO SMOKING AND NO MOBILE PHONES IN THIS AREA!

Time Checks:-

- Will be marked with a white flag at 200m and a yellow flag 20m before the check.
- You must not pass the yellow flag to check in before your designated time.
- Timing as per British Championship.

Special Test:-

This is not available for viewing. This is due to the fact that we are on a working farm. Riders must stop at the start of the test sign "A". The end of the test, indicated by sign "B", will be of the flying finish type and riders need not stop.

The first lap through the test will be a untimed giving rider ample opportunity to view the test, **Any rider found in the test before the start of the event will be excluded.**

Environmental:-

The use of power washers, anywhere on the farm, is strictly prohibited. Any rider or member of their support team found in breach of this rule will have the bike and rider excluded from the event.

All Riders (and their support team) must, when refuelling or maintaining their bikes, use an environmental mat, (eg piece of carpeting).

General:-

- Any unauthorized person found riding a motorcycle or other vehicle on the farm at any time before or after the event will be reported to the relevant authorities and excluded from this and subsequent Melville events.
- At all times competitors and their support crews must give way to other farm users. Stop and switch off engines if necessary.
- No dogs unless under control and on a lead at all times.
- Please take your litter home and respect the Country & Sporting Codes.
