The SACU is looking for applications from Scottish club teams who wish to enter the ISDE in 2019. For 2019 the ACU has announced that there may be spaces for 8-9 teams from the UK. The SACU has been allocated one team at present. See the ACU Press release here -

Clubs who wish to send a team to the ISDE are asked to contact the SACU office office@sacu.co.uk to register their interest before the end of November 2018. Team members can be nominated later once the ACU calls for team names.

Any Clubs who wish to send a team must nominate a Team Manager for the event before their application will be accepted by the ACU. Clubs will also have to provide 2 persons to travel to the event and act as support crew. A deposit to ensure clubs are committed will also have to be sent to the ACU along with the Team Manager form prior to 12th December 2018.

Riders who may wish to participate need to be aware of the cost of the event – currently approx. £5,000 plus bike.

Rider Entry Criteria

The SACU is looking for SACU licence holders who currently compete in the BEC or at European / World level events and also compete in Scottish Enduro / Hare and Hounds events. Riders will be doing their own maintenance at the event after riding eight hour days – so need to be competent mechanics as well as experienced riders.

The ISDE is the Olympics of Off Road Motorcycle sport and a fantastic challenge. Upcoming riders are encouraged to apply to their club if they meet the criteria and are able to fund the event.

Clubs sending in team applications would be expected to assist the riders during the coming year with fund raising and support at the event.
