Entry declaration: I / we the undersigned apply to enter the event described above and in consideration thereof:

- I / we hereby declare that I / we have had the opportunity to read, and that I / we understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU/SACU Standing Regulations, such Supplementary Regulations as have or may be issued for the event, and agree to be bound by them.
- I / we further declare that I am / we are physically and mentally fit +to take part in the event and I am / we are competent to do so
- I / we confirm that I / we understand the nature and type of event we are entering and its inherent risks and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risks may involve negligence on the part of the organisers or officials.
- I accept that insurance arranged on my behalf by the organisers of events that I may enter specifically excludes liability between the participants. I understand that this form may be used in litigation as evidence that any serious injury will be principally the result of my voluntary decision to engage in high risk activity.

- DATE :- Saturday 27th and Sunday 28th July**
- VENUE :- Heriot. Access from the A7 signed to B 709. Please note this is a new venue not the same as last year post code EH38 5YE**
- COURSE :- Approx 25 miles over open farmland, woodland and open moor, marked by tape and day glo arrows.**
- Camping :-** There will be a designated area for camping on Friday and Saturday night. Bikes must not be started between the hours of **6.30pm and 9am** on Friday, Saturday or Sunday. The camping / paddock area is directly adjacent to our host community, please act with respect by keeping noise, especially in the evening to a minimum, and take your litter home. All generators must be placed on an environmental mat and **must not be run between 10:30pm and 8:00am**

Strictly no fires of any kind

No mini bikes are allowed in the paddock / camping area, please leave them at home as you will not be allowed to use them. **Please take all your rubbish home with you , this is a livestock grazing area.**
No dogs unless under control and on a lead at all times.

- Scrutineering :-** 9.00 AM, until 10:00 Penalty for late machine examination -60 points First man away 10:30.
- MACHINES :-** Must be clearly numbered on front and side panels (with correct colour front background Red/green Expert, Yellow Clubman, club B , Blue Over 40 & over 50, Black Sportsman) , engine noise must not exceed **94** dba. There will be no restriction on tyre type.
- PARC FERME :-** ***Machines must not be started or worked on in the Parc Ferme.***
- REFUELLING :-** Will be restricted to an area designated for refuelling and will be marked by green flags. No smoking will be permitted in or near this area. Engines must be stopped during refuelling. All riders must provide a fire extinguisher and environmental mat.
No fuelling in grassed car parking camping area
- HELMETS :-** Gold or silver A.C.U. current stamped helmets must be worn.
- I.D. Discs :-** Must be worn giving name, date of birth and blood group if known.
- Entries and fees :-** will not be returned unless the event is cancelled or a rider gives a valid reason for not riding at least seven days prior to the event. In such cases £10 will be deducted to cover costs. Any rider not signing on, on the day, will forfeit his entry fee in full
